Pryde's Easifeed Golden Guitar Matthew Harding will treasure his return trip to Tamworth after taking out the \$25,000 Prydes Easifeed Golden Guitar Final with Strathlachlan Andy. Growing up around Tamworth, Harding had many trial drives on the Paceway before gaining his licence. "It's good to win a race anywhere but to come back here, to win the biggest race of the year is a big thrill" said Harding. Matthew races the 5yo Blissfull Hall-Strathlachlan Gem gelding leaving the training to his father Geoff, who himself has had a winning drive in a Golden Guitar Final back in January 2007 when he piloted Lets Ride the Tide to victory. "I have driven a winner of the Golden Guitar before but this is probably just a bit better" said Geoff Harding "I told Matthew to go out and show me how it is done" added the proud father. "It's the pinnacle" added Geoff Harding at the post race presentation "it is a family affair". The enthusiastic crowd on hand also enjoyed witnessing another track record being broken with the win of Strathlachlan Andy, when he clocked 1.58.1 for 1980 metres, breaking the track record set by last year's winner Goldplay (1.58.3). Strathlachlan Andy finished second in the first heat to Happyever Laughter and came into the final with a tough barrier draw of 11. Harding played a cool hand at the tail of the field before sending Strathlachlan Andy three wide just before the bell, to come away for a 4 metre win over Bathurst pacer Marguez (Ashlee Siejka) with Tangles (Nathan Hurst) third. Strathlachlan Andy has been a handy horse having 33 starts for 12 wins, 13 placings and over \$77,000.

**Golden Guitar Form is Strong** Punters who have been following pacers that raced at our recent Pryde's EasiFeed Golden Guitar Carnival have been cleaning up. As in the past the form from our three "premium" meets in the Carnival of Cups holds very true and many horses have since greeted the judge all over NSW. Those pacers include:

\* at Newcastle 29/1 - Better Than Max 1.59.9 & Lavra Bhutan 2.00.6 \* at Menangle 30/1 - Mister Chow 1.57.9 \* at Newcastle 3/2 - Black Belt 1.58.3, Kardashian crusader 1.58.1 & Courage Underwater 1.58.1 \* at Dubbo 4/2 - Tulhurst Courage 1.57.4 & Tommy Tuppence 2.00.4 \* at Newcastle 6/2 - Bien Hoa 1.56.5, Strathlachlan Andy 1.57.2 (since won at Menangle 14/2 in 1.54.9) & Glenisla 1.55.5. Also Yayas Hot Spot, the easy winner of Garrard's Tamworth City Cup in track record time ventured to Melton on February 6 for an excellent 2m 3rd to Yankee Rockstar in 1.52.4 in the \$30000 Group 3 Garrards 4YO Bonanza. \* Angus G won at Redcliffe on the 11/2. The Pub Group Gold Nugget Nathan Hurst took out The Pub Group sponsored Gold Nugget with Major Gambler, one of his treble for the night. Hurst, who trains his team near Bathurst, drove Major Gambler to a thrilling win in the \$8000 feature which included a Gold Nugget as the winning trophy on the opening night of the three day race carnival. "I will have to go for a drink now at one of The Pub Group's venues" he joked after the win. "He is a horse who always runs into places in big races and he is not really a lucky horse but we had luck tonight" said Hurst. Major Gambler had a short half head win over race favourite Millwood Liberty (Mark Callaghan) and Queensland pacer Katesaroyal (Brendan Barnes) from the Bart Cockburn stables third. Nathan's other winners were Tangles who took out the first race and Kyalla Dave who won the Bushwacker's Pace.



#### Nevele R Stud Star Maker 3yo Final

Glenisla was one of the treble driven by Lauren Panella and trained by Shane Tritton when taking out the \$15,000 Nevele R Stud Star Maker 3yo Final after winning her heat. Make Mine Grange (Josh Willick) led the field as the bell sounded whilst Glenisla raced out in the breeze with Glenisla holding on over a fast finishing Soynwasabi (Matt Neilson) with Make Mine Grange third. "She is going to be a tough filly when she learns what to do" said Panella. "The track is in great condition and it has been a great night" said Panella. Tritton was happy with the three wins for the night and was full of praise for the Tamworth Carnival. "We love supporting these sorts of races especially this Club as they probably started me off on a good thing a couple of years ago and it's good to be back" said Tritton.



**TRACK ON FIRE** Despite a late morning downpour at Tamworth on January 23 the track was in tip-top condition for racing for our premium Carnival of Cups meet by 6.40pm first race time. Track curator Laurie James, Des Constable & David Pike are to be commended for their untiring efforts to have the racing surface, not only ready but in perfect condition, as evidenced by three new track records. Yayas Hot Spot obliterated the 2360m track record in winning the \$10,000 Garrards Tamworth City Cup, recording 2.51.8, a rate of 1.57.2, taking a massive 3.2 seconds off the 2010 mark of Enjays Cam. The mile rate is guicker than Youranut's 1609m track record of 1.57.3. The 1980m track record of 2.25.5 was also bettered by Strathlachlan Andy who ran 2.25.3 (rating 1.58.1.) in winning the \$25000 Pryde's EasiFeed Golden Guitar Final. The other record to fall was the 3vo fillies for 1980m that went to Glenisla in winning her heat of the Nevele R Star Maker in 2.29.4 (rating 2.01.4) eclipsing the 2000 mark of Somewhat Fancy.

Garrards Tamworth City Cup Yayas Hotspot annihilated his opposition with a 42 metre win in the \$12,000 Garrards Horse and Hound Tamworth City Cup. Lauren Panella dictated terms out in front and had an all the way win. "He is a good horse and has run some good races against the likes of Bling It On" said trainer Shane Tritton. "We knew the Cup would be a nice race for him. He probably needed that run as he has got some big races ahead of him. He loves the smaller tracks, but we will head for the Chariots now and then probably come back and do a bit of a Carnival run" said Tritton "he is only a 4yo, similar to Mach Beauty and on the way up". Lauren Panella stated "this horse can do some freakish things". Yaya's Hot Spot defeated local Soho Eros (Peter Missen) and Katesaroyal (Brendan Barnes).

\* Ultimate Art, a 5yo entire by Modern Art, won a \$50,000 Inter Dominion heat over 2400m in 1.57.0 for his 19th victory for Michael Formosa and has earnt \$305,000. Last year, after winning The Pub Group Gold Nugget he was beaten into 4th in the Garrard's Tamworth City Cup by local champ Soho Eros.
