Jye had five (5) drives at the race meeting, his first ever race drive being in Race 1 on the program, *The TAB App Maiden Pace*, which saw his runner take third place, but resulted in a very nervous visit to the Stewards Room soon afterwards and a reprimand for shifting ground under pressure. This drive was followed by a ninth placing in Race 5, a second place by only a head in Race 7 and then a sixth place for the Shepherdson stable in Race 8. But the best of the day came in the last on the program, *The John's Auto Service Tamworth Pace*, with the ultimate first career win by 3.3 metres driving COLBY NZ for his father Greg's on-course stable. Congratulation Jye. At the conclusion of the meeting, it was back to Cessnock for Jye, where he is currently working for the Clayton Harmey Stable, a drive for whom at the Newcastle Paceway the next night saw a second place by half-neck for Jye behind ROCKLEA IMAGE in *The Wandiyali - Keep Our Culture Strong Pace*.
