Raceday Stabling. A reminder all horses must be stabled 1 hour before their race and remain in the stabling area for half an hour after their event. On leaving the race day stabling the freeze brand must be checked. A misunderstanding at a recent meeting exposed a weakness in our system and for integrity reasons the change is necessary. It will a short inconvenience for people with horses but remember there will be an extra 80 horses to be checked by the official. Please help by allowing time for your horses to be checked and treat the official with the respect you would want to be treated with. Please be advised HRNSW rules state that children under the age of 14 are not allowed entry to the stabling area on course.


