ANOTHER HIGHLY SUCCESSFUL JANUARY RACING CARNIVAL HAS BEEN COMPLETED

The Carnival commenced with the traditional The Pub Group Race Meeting which featured the running of the annual PUB GROUP GOLD NUGGET, with prizemoney of \$10,000 and a Gold Nugget as the owners trophy. The race over 1980 metres was won by Hunter Valley stabled 5 year old gelding ROYAL GAMBLE NZ, trained by Mark Callaghan and driven by Jack Callaghan in a time of MR 1:57.7.

Day Two of the Carnival on Sunday 19th January saw the staging of five heats for the \$50,000 Group 2 Golden Guitar Final. This meeting also saw the running of the HYGAIN STAR MAKER for 3 Year Olds, won in a time of MR 1:57.9 by the Jarrod Alchin trained and Brad Elder driven MY ULTIMATE STAR.

Then came the main meeting of the Carnival on Thursday Evening 23rd January, with the drought continuing and a maximum temperature of 39 degrees, the peace of the day was broken by a huge dust storm which blew in from the west, greatly reducing visability and depositing brown dirt everywhere. Before the meeting a light shower of rain then followed but by racetime all had settled down and the meeting progressed to schedule, although with gusty winds for the remainer of the evening. The meeting included the running of:

- The \$50,000 MULTIQUIP GROUP 2 GOLDEN GUITAR FINAL, was won with a mile rate of 1:57.7 over the 1980 metre distance by the Clayton Harmey trained and Leigh Sutton driven 4 year old gelding, WET MY WHISTLE NZ.
- The GARRARDS HORSE AND HOUND TAMWORTH CITY CUP which was won by 7 year old gelding GOTTASHOPEARLY, making it back to back wins, in a time of MR 2:00.5 over the 2360 metre distance, having been trained this year by part owner Jake Mitchell and driven by Leigh Sutton.
- The HAZELLS FARM & FERTILIZER SERVICES LOCAL PACE which was won by Duri stabled OVERTHEMOON, trained by Andy Ison and driven by his Hunter Valley based son Tom Ison in a time of MR 2:00.5 over the 1980 metre distance.
