GOLDEN GUITAR ATTAINS GROUP 2 STATUS



25th June 2019—Golden Guitar upgrade to Group 2

On Tuesday 25th June, NSW Minister for Better Regulation, Kevin Anderson MP in the company of Rod Smith - Chair HRNSW, John Dumesny - CEO HRNSW, Julie Maughan - Chair THRC and Joyce Walsh - Deputy Chair THRC, announced that from January 2020 the annual Tamworth Golden Guitar Race would carry prizemoney of \$50,000 elevating it to Group 2 status.

The 2020 three (3) meeting Golden Guitar Carnival will see a record quarter-of-a-million-dollars in prizemoney distributed.

Tamworth HRC Chairperson Julie Maughan was thrilled by the announcement, "Absolutely Rapt" Mrs Maughan said.

The Tamworth Harness Racing Club Board gladly received the news that the long standing \$25,000 Listed Classic Golden Guitar Final race has had an injection into the prizemoney purse with the race now offering \$50,000 in prizemoney and also being elevated to Group 2, commencing with the January 2020 running.

The Golden Guitar race itself deserves the recognition with its longevity alone, with it being part of the Tamworth HRC January Racing Carnival, attracting many a fine horse to contest the race over the years and being recognised as the most prestigious harness racing event in the north-west.

Minister responsible for racing and Better Regulation, Kevin Anderson, said the announcement shows that regional racing keeps going from strength to strength.

"We want our regional racing scene to continue to grow, which is why this investment in Tamworth's Golden Guitar Harness Race is so important," said Mr Anderson. "The Country Music Festival in Tamworth is such an iconic event and we can celebrate an iconic harness race as part of it."

The Board of the Tamworth HRC - Chair Julie Maughan, Deputy Joyce Walsh and Directors Graham Moon, Scotty-Jon Welsh and Nicholas Walsh are most certainly ensuring that the Club continues to flourish. After being awarded the HRNSW Award for New Innovation (Promotion/Marketing) last year, the Group 2 Golden Guitar status race is most certainly another indication, that the Country Club is moving forward.

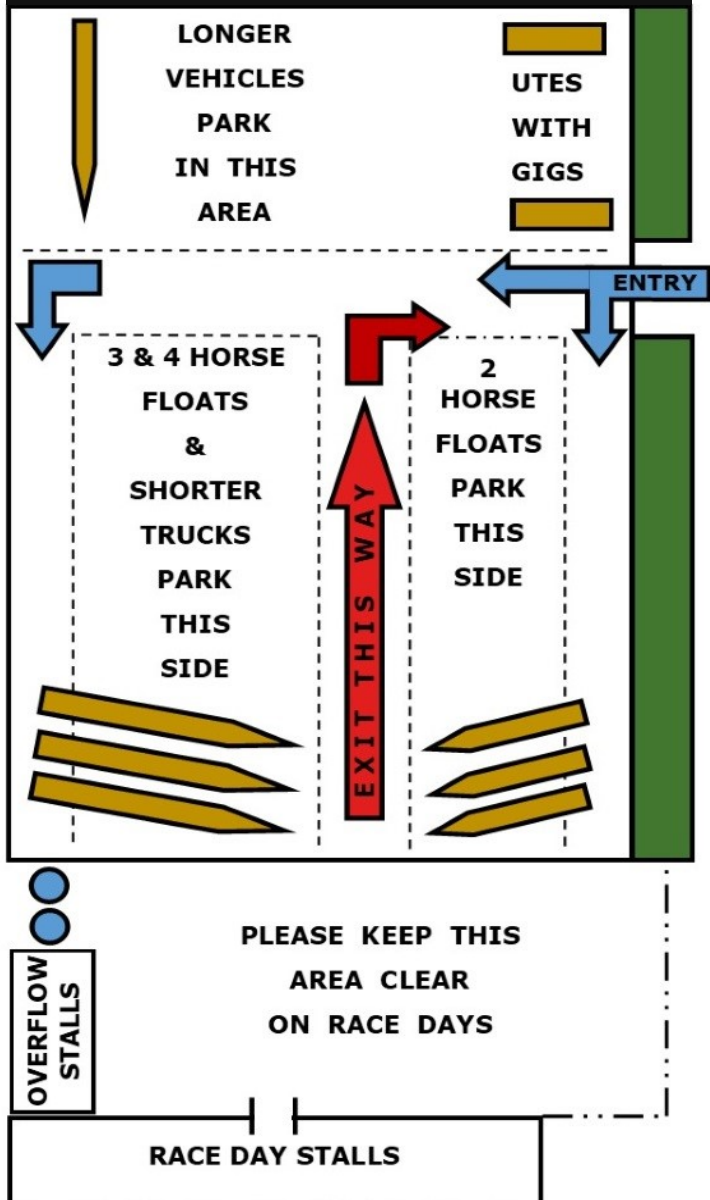

FLOAT PARKING AREA



On Race and Trial days the new horse float parking area is in use. All vehicles carrying horses and/or gigs must enter into the float parking area which is accessed at the top of the main drive then via the entrance way between the two sets of green timber stables. This parking area is fenced off from the remainder of the paceway for security and safety.

Please observe the arrows on the adjacent schematic, following the blue arrows to enter and the red arrows to leave, always leaving the central area marked by red post traffic bollards free for exiting vehicles. All vehicles should park facing the central exit road.

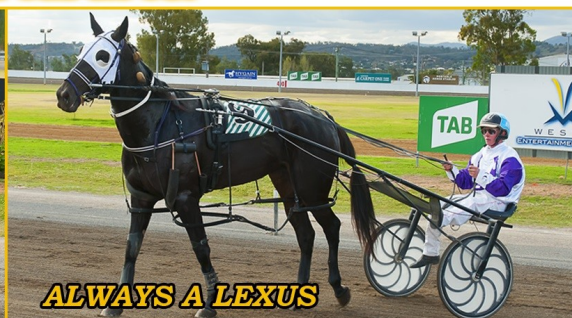

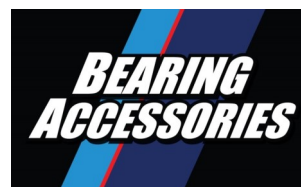
