TRACK RESURFACING:

During early April, the Club arranged for the Tamworth Paceway track to be resurfaced. Club Sponsor • and local business, Roadwork Industries were again engaged to do the job with Bathurst Track Curator, Tony Hagney on hand to ensure the job was completed to the highest standards. Initially the current track surface was ripped and regraded to correct the cambers to 3% on the straights and 6% on the bends with the original track design transitions reinstated.

Four hundred tonnes on new crushed rock surface material was then spread, trimmed, water and rolled over two days to attain the new racing surface.

Now that the new central roof of the Race Day Stalls Complex is completed, construction has now moved outside to the extra 12 stalls and the new Float Carpark.
