2017 TAMWORTH CARNIVAL OF CUPS Pryde's Easifeed Golden Guitar Final

He was a 50/1 shot but Magoogan turned out to be the worthy winner of the \$25,000 Pryde's Easifeed Golden Guitar Final for 2017 in an action packed race. The win presented Ellalong trainer Michael Formosa his second Golden Guitar Final and although he has trained two winners, driving the winner has eluded him each time. Xavier won back in 2009 for Formosa with Cameron Davies in the spider. Roll forward to the 2017 running and Formosa once again had two runners engaged -Somemondosomewhere and Magoogan - who both won their heats. Formosa elected drive Somemondo somewhere from the seven barrier while he secured the services of Mark Callaghan to take the reins behind Magoogan from nine. "Mark and I have been friends since High School so it was real good to see Mark drive the winner" said a happy Formosa. Both the horses were going good, their runs in the heats were good runs so they both deserved to be in the final. I was confident Magoogan could win if he got the right run" added Formosa. Mark Callaghan said "there was a bit of trouble in the race and we had to duck and swerve a few times but we got through luckily and it probably helped him when we ducked back to the inside on the turn and he dug deep in to hold Courtsinsession on the line. He did hang in a bit but he showed how good he is to win". Magoogan held on for a head win over Courtsinsession with Real Social 3 metres away third in





1.58.7. It was the five year old Santanna Blue Chip — Amber Loofah gelding's third win on the trot at the Tamworth Paceway. "He has always been consistent but since he has come back from a spell he is a bit sharper — hopefully he will go through his grades" added Formosa. Julie Maughan.

Garrards Tamworth City Cup was taken out by Better Than Max driven by Sydney reinsman Brendan Barnes. Two years ago the 19 year old finished third in the Tamworth Cup behind the Bart Cockburn trained Katesaroyal. "He had good form going into the race" said Barnes. "I have seen the horse race around Menangle and I was confident before the race just on his class". Trained at Medowie by Darren Reay, Better Than Max has had 17 career wins - which included three wins at Menangle with the last visit to Tamworth being back in December 2015 also showing a win – and 32 placing from 72 career starts. "He was the best horse in the race and you can drive them a bit harder and it pays off – it was good to win a feature race at a carnival like Tamworth" added Barnes. Julie Maughan.



Tamworth HRC Star Maker Final "She went good – she went super" was how Bathurst trainer Bernie Hewitt summed up the win of I'm With Lexy in the \$15,000 Tamworth HRC Star Maker Final. "I thought she was capable of winning it – she is starting to get to the top of her game" said Hewitt. "I'm With Lexy (Roll With Joe USA- Laughing Lexy) is continuing on like her older sister" added Hewitt, with the older sister being Read About Lexy who had 22 starts for 11 wins and nine placings and over \$150,000 prizemoney. Both pacers are owned by Lex Crosby who was at Tamworth to witness the win in the feature race for three year olds. Bernie Hewitt is no stranger to the Tamworth Paceway and won a Tamworth Cup "about ten years ago". I'm With Lexy went straight to the lead from the four barrier to lead the field up with the John McCarthy trained and driven Bettor Be Gold racing out in the breeze. "John realised I wanted to hold the lead. Bettor Be Gold is a tough horse and it is hard to race outside another horse - but I knew my filly wouldn't lay down and she managed to have a little in reserve at the end" said Hewitt. A brilliant and accurate **Tentpegging Display** was enjoyed by the crowd at the Golden Guitar Carnival of Cups meeting. Thanks to our Clerks of Course Barry Biffin and Bryson Roser along with Todd Carey. All three plus Sarah Rushbrook also did a great job of carrying the placards for the Golden Guitar pre-parade.



The Pub Group Gold Nugget was won by Culinary Delight trained and driven by Hunter Valley reinsman Mark Callaghan. With race favourite Captain Rockey (David Grant) utilising the number one barrier and holding the lead Callaghan popped in on the leaders back. "I was wrapped to get in there on the favourites back - I only had to get out then" said Callaghan. Carrying a flat tyre - which occurred on the first turn - Callaghan was happy with the run of Culinary Delight. "Horses that pull a flat tyre don't normally win these days" added Callaghan who took the \$10,000 feature and the gold nugget trophy by a neck over Captain Rockey right on the line with Sams Cam 10 metres away third. "I like coming here (Tamworth) it's a great Club - you get well looked after and the track is in great order" Callaghan enthused after the win. For Culinary Delight – a former Kiwi pacer – it has been a great success rate on the Tamworth Paceway with two starts producing two wins with the first back in December when the mare won the BMR Quarries Dash For Cash raced over the 1230 metre distance, setting a new track record with a mile rate of 1.53.6 before taking out the Gold Nugget feature raced over 1980 metres. Callaghan has had two other attempts at winning The Pub Group Gold Nugget feature race – back in 2015 he was beaten a short half head on race favourite Millwood Liberty and in the 2016 running he missed out again with Strawberry Courage - who also started as favourite. Maybe this time round Callaghan's change of luck came when he wasn't the race favourite with Culinary Delight paying \$7.50 for the win! Julie Maughan.


